Fig. 3a shows a photochromic solution contained in a cuvette and irradiated by UV only at the bottom through an optical fiber. The solution is maintained in an uncapped cuvette. The irradiation at the bottom triggers the photo-colouration of the photochromic solution. It also promotes a heating effect of the solution at the bottom.
