Conflict Resolution. Any dispute between the Parties arising out of or relating to this Agreement that is not settled amicably shall be submitted to arbitration at the request of either Party. Each Party shall appoint one arbitrator, and the two so appointed shall jointly appoint a third who shall be Chairperson.

What Is Dispute Resolution in Construction Contracts?

Either Party may initiate the dispute resolution process by first writing a letter to the other party indicating the issue (s) in dispute and the proposed manner in which to settle the dispute. The recipient of the letter shall respond within ten (10) days to the proposed solution.

One of the best ways to make sure that a conflict is resolved constructively is to include conciliation clauses in any contracts you sign. These clauses are legally enforceable and require that any dispute related to the contract be resolved through biblically—based mediation or arbitration rather than through litigation.
