Self-Determination Theory suggests that when the situation fosters competence, relatedness and autonomy, people are more motivated to act; when it hinders those feelings, people are less motivated and less happy (Ryan and Deci, 2000): we can use goals to increase students' feelings of competence, and, perhaps, their autonomy. Goals foster ...

Motivating students: setting goals for autonomy and competence

Pair struggling students with students of higher ability or greater knowledge and skills, as this may result in students becoming dependent (rather than independent) learners. Unless higher ability students across the age-span are trained to work as positive tutors, motivation to learn can suffer for students at both ends of the ability or knowledge spectrums.
