Intonation - Learning the Cello and Teaching the Cello

The question at hand, therefore, is what are some basic ways we can develop better intonation on the cello. First, let's define faulty intonation. Faulty intonation is the failure to tune intervals (the distance between pitches), both melodically and harmonically (intervals played harmonically are notes that sound simultaneously and melodic intervals are played successively).

As a cello teacher, I have always spent a great deal of time working on intonation with my students. Being able to explain theories about intonation has made it much easier, but I always try to emphasize that in the end it is all about listening and adjusting.

This can even happen on a cello that is in tune but being played with bad intonation. On a cello where all the strings are a little bit off pitch, it is impossible not to have negative or misaligned resonances with at least two strings, and if you are resonating with one of them, then you are still playing out of tune and likely messing up your ear!

Intonation, a Physical Phenomenon

For instance, if I pluck (energy) the C-string on a cello the string will vibrate at a rate of 130.8 times (cycles) per second. This vibration produces what we call "C₄ (natural)". Simply put, intonation is producing a pitch at a particular frequency.
