Traditionally, self-deception has been modeled on interpersonal deception, where A intentionally gets B to believe some proposition p , all the while knowing or believing truly that $\sim p$. Such deception is intentional and requires the deceiver to know or believe that $\sim p$ and the deceived to believe that p .
