It is the Maximum Capacity of the mooring winch brake to hold the mooring drum in its position when under tension. Technically, Brake Holding Capacity of a winch is 80% of the MBL of the Mooring Rope, but it is set at 60% of the MBL, allowing 20% margin for safety (OCIMF guidelines). Above this figure (of 60%), the brake renders.

Mooring lines and fenders in good condition. Paddles or oars. Tool kit and spare parts (including light bulbs, fuses). Bilge free of fuel vapors and excess water. Fuel supply full. Fuel system free of leaks. Engine oil and transmission fluid levels correct. Battery fully charged, fluid level full. Electronic gear in good condition.
