Where overall crop productivity is low, crop protection is largely limited to some weed control, and actual losses to pests may account for more than 50 % of the attainable production (Oerke 2005 ).

Under the Food Quality Protection Act (FQPA), EPA must ensure that all pesticides used on food in the United States meet FQPA's stringent safety standard. FQPA requires an explicit determination that a pesticide's use on food is safe for children and includes an additional safety factor, tenfold unless data show a different factor to be protective, to account for uncertainty in data relative ...

Pesticides are chemical compounds that are used to kill pests, including insects, rodents, fungi and unwanted plants (weeds). Over 1000 different pesticides are used around the world. Food Safety. Pesticides are commonly used on the food we eat to control pests that may damage the crops during production, storage or transport. Pesticides allow growers to increase the amount of usable food from each crop at the time of harvest. Pesticides may also improve the quality, safety, and shelf-life of certain foods.

One study showed 3% of Polish apples contained pesticide levels above the legal safety limit for pesticides on food . However, the levels were not high enough to cause harm, even in children.

### Are Pesticides in Foods Harming Your Health?

People spreading pesticide on crops, in homes, or in gardens should be adequately protected. People not directly involved in the spread of pesticides should stay away from the area during and just after a spread. Food that is sold or donated (such as food aid) should comply with pesticide regulations, in particular with maximum residue limits.

### Pesticide residues in food

As a consequence, persistent residues of these chemicals contaminate food and disperse in the environment. Coordinated efforts are needed to increase the production of food but with a view to enhanced food quality and safety as well as to controlling residues of persistent pesticides in the environment.
